The 2016 Saint Golf Team had 28 players on the roster between varsity, junior varsity, and developmental teams and was very active throughout the spring CIF season. Coaches Jess Wilson, Tom Graciano, Bill Davis, Christian Da Luz and Tom Isaak guided the team all around San Diego County (and Palm Springs for one large tournament). For our team banquet, Saintsman Nick Giordano (class of 2006), member of the 2005 California State Champions team, was our featured guest speaker. To the team and parents, Nick gave some great stories and advice that was both informative and fun to hear. Nick's main theme related to the close amount of teamwork that was shown by all the players

Junior varsity highlights:

- 1. Competed in 19 matches, finishing with a 12-7 record;
- 2. Finished in 2nd place in two year-end tournaments (Francis Parker Invitational at Mission Trails GC and Best of Rest Tournament at National City GC).

The varsity team

- 1. Ended the season with a 10-11 record
- 2. Beat 2016 California State Champions Torrey Pines High School at their home course in a 9 hole match
- 3. Coming off of a Saints team best 8th place finish out of 45 teams at the Champions Invitational in 2015, finished in 29th place this season with 3 new players on the roster
- 4. Qualified for the San Diego CIF Sectional event at Admiral Baker GC as the #4 seed in Division 2 (ranked #9 throughout the regular season in all of San Diego County)

Fundraiser at Mt. Woodson set for Sunday September 18th – continued booster support sought in the form of purchasing a foursome at our main fundraiser:

With the largest roster of players in all of San Diego goes the highest course fees - over \$8,500 was paid by the Saints team to cover rounds of golf at our home courses of Riverwalk GC, Miramar GC, and Cottonwood GC as well as entry fees for events. When added to the costs for \$200 PING Saints golf bags, team shirts, pullovers and other team items for all 28 players on the roster, our overall expenses are quite large. To fund this ambitious undertaking, we will be hosting our 5th annual team fundraiser at Mt. Woodson GC in Ramona on Sunday September 18th. It will be very similar to prior events: \$125 entry fee per person (\$500 per foursome) includes a BBQ from 11:00-12:30pm and a 1:00pm shotgun start. Following the round, there is no commitment other than picking up any items you won during the event or in the raffle.

At this time, we are asking for commitments for foursomes (or you can commit as a single, twosome or threesome and we will pair you up with other boosters). For those boosters who commit and pay prior to August 15th, a special bonus in the form of a dozen Saints logo Titleist Pro V golf balls will be given at Mt.
