Recently, Anthony had his first tournament experience in a North County Junior Golf Association event. With more upcoming events this summer, Anthony is excited to join the team and make his mark at Saints;

After playing in multiple varsity matches throughout the season and continually improving as the high school year progressed, Alex' next goal is to establish himself as a varsity golfer next season. Tyler has also begun working at The Vineyard this summer to better immerse himself in the game of golf and learn about different aspects of what goes into successfully running a golf course;
- Senior 3-year letterman Haytham Yousif is in the middle of a busy summer, to say the least. Playing in Washington state (and still proudly sporting his "Saints Golf" bag!!), Teddy finished in 18th place out of 72 golfers with scores of 73-73-74. At the AJGA event held at Yorba Linda Country Club last month, Teddy was in the running to win the event with solid rounds of 70-74-71, which earned him a 6th place finish out of 75 golfers.
