Cathedral falls short in loss to Saints

Dons go to the air in second-half rally

SAN DIEGO — The lone bright spot for Cathedral Catholic High is that it still can call itself Eastern League co-champions — but with an asterisk.

St. Augustine will take home the tiebreaker after beating the Dons 28-21 before an overflow crowd of more than 5,000 fans Friday night at Mesa College.

The Saints (8-2, 4-1) mounted a 21-0 advantage before Cathedral Catholic

“Our coaches told us we’d change the game plan in the second half and go to the air more,” said Dons receiver Chance Early, who hauled in a 14-yard touchdown pass with 7:04 remaining to trim the deficit to a touchdown. “Every chance I had, I just tried to get to the ball and do something with it.

“At least our defense gave us a chance to come back in the second half.”

However, Saints running back Aaron Anderson controlled the ground game, rushing 16 times for 136 yards and the opening touchdown. The balanced attack had quarterback Evan Crower (13-of-24, 170 yards) toss scoring passes to Darren Critchlow (11 yards), Nicholas Gonsalves (43) and Sean Davey (33).

Cathedral Catholic answered on a Jonny Martin run of 15 yards in the final minute of the first half, following three punts. Bogart broke around right tackle on a 26-yard scramble to trim the deficit to 28-14 in the third quarter.
