<u>New Theater</u> is an "amazing" space with training coming for all technology. The facility has over 10,000 light presets, 4K video projection, seats 400 participants and a great space for future APA lecture series.

<u>Student Transitions</u> (students coming and going between different schools) is the most in the past decade. While it has been a net gain of two students, we have seen boys transferring between Bishops. Cathedral, Mater Dei and Saints. Enrollment at Saints is full.

<u>A New Website</u> greats our parents at the start of the year. While the content remains the same there is a new look and feel to the site.

Seek Wisdom is this year's theme for Saints. St. Augustine wrote in his 55th letter that "anything stemming from love must be good." We must seek balance for our boys. Hospitality will be sending out email blast during meet the teacher night and sending out information during the first week of school. Treats and drinks will be made available during meet the teacher night.


Freshman Representative will be Kimy Erpelding who will be communicating to the class through the Principal's office.

You are receiving this email because you expressed interest in a Saints Ride Share email list for those travelling interstate (5, 805, 15, 8). This initial email is being sent to all who inquired about sharing rides to and from Saints on a preferred route.

To connect with families in your area and arrange rides simply send an email message to this ride share email list. Families can then COMMUNICATE directly with others looking for or providing rides to and from school and activities.

Saints expects permission for such transportation to be arranged between parents of all minors and to be consistent with DMV guidelines, particularly about probationary drivers and associated restrictions.

Tips to consider for Ride Share ...

- After you connect with a Saints family that is potentially compatible for carpooling arrange carpool pick up details (times and locations). Sometimes door to door rides are preferred, sometimes families meet at a public space near a freeway on-ramp.
- Discuss how to divide up driving. Some carpool groups use one driver/car and some groups will have a different car/driver daily.
- Driver's in your Ride Share group should always carry a valid Driver's License, registration, and insurance.
- Create/Discuss agreements in advance for cell phone use, routes travelled, campus parking, temperature, the need for "gas money" even radio stations!
- When you create your schedule, discuss whether your group will wait for latecomers.
- Everyone in the Ride Share group should share contact information, including cell phone numbers and email addresses. Keep a print-out of everyone's contact information in your vehicle, just in case someone is running late!
- Be sure to communicate with others if your daily situation conflicts with your Ride Share commitments.

We are hopeful that finding a solution to some of your transportation challenges makes travelling to and from school a bit less stressful.
