## Principal's Report - Jim Horne

Busy times during the month of March. Integral Student Outcomes - ISO writing exams are taken to ensure our boys are developing into Christian gentlemen. Students focus on the four ISOs as they journey through their developing years at Saints. Students write a draft during the homeroom and submit (pass/fail) to substantiate through examples how they are taking on the ISOs.

Admissions are intentionally two weeks behind the other schools by design as we are not in the business of comparing financial packages.

Ride Share is still looking to build carpools for families that are living further away from Saints. We are looking to send emails three times per year as reminders. We are interested in getting feedback for opportunities to improve the process. New parent night and Entrance Exam is a space to market to parents about the opportunity. An official relaunch will take place in August. We want support for North County parents to ease the stress on transportation to campus. It was recommended to consider including in regular e-Blast from administration. Certain sports are more challenge to support due to distance of practice location. The cost to the site to support our own shuttle service would be in excess of $\$ 35,000$ per van and would be a direct impact to school tuition and Saints has chosen not to incur this cost.

APA Positions are being added as parents move on with with their son's graduating. The President and Treasurer positions are open with candidates moving forward (and voting as needed) at our next regular meeting. The Saint Mary's Prayer Group is in need of a new representative.
