Class Representative Reports - Nothing to report.

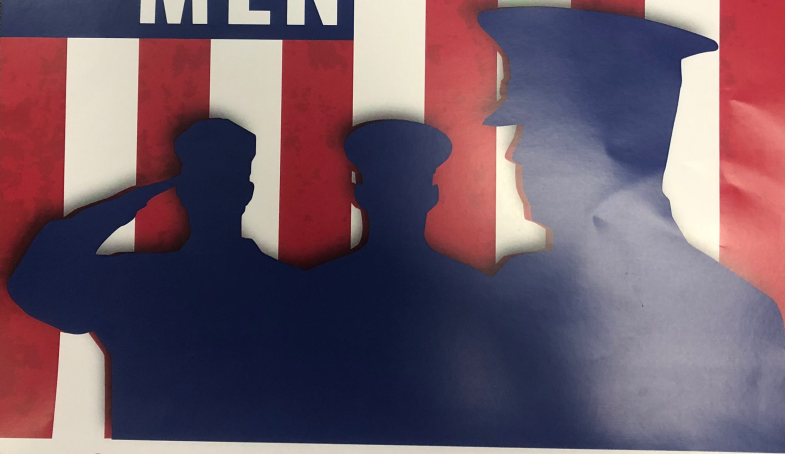
