- -Call to Order and Prayer
- -Introductions of those present (approx. 15): New officers, event chairs and volunteers

## Mr. Horne:

- -Dads needed for the APA! Father volunteers are important for our events and volunteer efforts.
- -We need a Freshman class APA representative. If interested let us know/come to next meeting.
- -This is a community building organization. Our focus is not fundraising. Our mission is to invite people in and host events to build the Saints community.
- -Recent improvements have been made to the school: 1) Beautiful new field and track- under budget and ready early; 2) Painted Vasey Hall
- -New Art teacher just hired- Brandon Seacrest. He is a local North Park area dad, and his artwork is featured in multiple galleries around town.
- -There is a PSA flight crash memorial currently being constructed on the side of the school on Palm; it will be a small prayer garden (Note Sept. 25 is the dedication of the memorial- Palm will be closed on that block for the ceremony and there will be impacts to drop off/pick up on that side of the school)

# Natalie Boeh (APA President):

- -For volunteer registration purposes, there is a proposal to change from Sign up genius to Evite; it will help for keeping lists of volunteers, there are new Evite features make it more like Sign up genius but better, we will do a test run for the family BBQ in early Sept.
- -Leona sent out a highlights calendar item with the July newsletter. Many, but not all, events are listed.
- -Discussion over whether there is a way to do a QR code at the family gathering, 8/24-25 new parent cocktail parties or freshman orientation (8/14-8 am), to gather information on potential volunteers.

#### Upcoming Fall events discussed:

- -St. Monica's prayer group potluck dates: Dates are going into Saints scene. Mass time has changed from 7:50 to 8 am in morning. First potluck is Sept. 12. Trying to get dates into the school calendar because some dates vary for the masses and potlucks.
- -The calendar has been generally updated to include more times and will try to update events that do not have times.
- -All senior events dates are set. Grad night location is not yet confirmed. Prom was booked 2 years ago. Graduation related dates are not changeable.
- -2024-2025 Year stats: 203 freshman. 721 students in the school.
